DANCE RULES AND REGULATIONS

The school climate at VINAL Technical High School is characterized by respect for the rights and dignity of others. Students are expected and required to behave in a socially appropriate manner while on school grounds or at school activities. This means students are expected to comply with school rules and regulations, to be courteous to each other and employees of the school district and to the volunteer chaperones, faculty, secretaries, custodians, and cafeteria employees.

In the event of illness or injury, the guest's parent/guardian will be contacted.

1. Guests must be at least a freshman in high school and under the age of 21.
2. Guests must be pre-approved by the administration. This form must be completed and signed by an administrator prior to purchasing tickets.
3. Only students on the guest list may attend the dance.
4. Students with outstanding obligations will NOT be allowed to purchase tickets or attend the dance.
5. The administration reserves the right to prohibit any student from attending school activities.
6. The dance is a school function and all school rules apply. Appropriate formal dress and behavior are expected. See the student Handbook for rules.
7. Students who are attending the dance must be in school for the entire day on the day of the dance. Students who are absent, cut class, arrive late, or leave school without permission will be removed from the guest list and will forfeit the cost of his/her ticket.
- 8. Doors open at 6:00pm. The dance ends at 10:00 pm. Students will NOT be permitted in after 7:00pm. *Students must leave school grounds immediately at the dance's conclusion.***
9. Once students enter the facility, they must stay. Students who leave the building will NOT be allowed to re-enter.
10. Since the dance is a school function, smoking and the use of tobacco are NOT permitted.
11. The use and/or possession of alcohol or drugs will result in suspension and referral to the police.
12. Students under the influence of drugs or alcohol will NOT be admitted. Parents will be notified, school suspension will be given, and referral to the police will occur.
13. Any damage to the facilities will be paid by the individuals who are responsible. Referral will also be made to parents, police, and school administrators for disciplinary action.
14. Class members attending the dance are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their guest.
15. Dancing must be appropriate at all times. Students dancing inappropriately (suggestive, vulgar, or offensive dancing and actions) will be asked to leave the dance.
